

handled confidentially and without prejudice; Lindley and Timmerman don't pass judgment on their clients' past organizational skills – or lack thereof.

"We guarantee that when we're done, you can find any piece of information, electronic or paper, in five seconds or less or your money back," Lindley said.

Her favorite tool for home organization is the plastic bin. They're affordable, "stackable," easily labeled and protect items from moisture and pests.
Lindley's favorite organizational tool for businesses is Paper Tiger Software.

One of Lindley's key organizational recommendations is making space by removing unused or underused items – clothing, office equipment, exercise machines, excess tools, etc.

"If you're not using it for any reason, donate it to someone who can," she said. "We can help identify charities for just about anything."
